Fire Investigator of the Year Award

Guidelines

Committee

Each year a committee of two (2) Directors and one (1) currently enrolled member will be appointed by the President to evaluate the nominations and select a recipient. The award will be presented at the Annual Conference Dinner with the recipient receiving a plaque.

Eligibility

- All public agency and private sector fire/explosion investigators, and investigative teams, that are members of the Florida Chapter.
- The investigator or unit should have demonstrated exceptional performance in the area of fire and explosion investigations.
- The investigator must have been a member of the Chapter for six (6) months prior to receiving the award.

Who can nominate an investigator?

Anyone can nominate an investigator for the award, i.e. fire/police chief, fire marshal, colleague, etc.

A nomination form shall be completed and accompanied by a letter explaining why this person should be considered for the award.
